

Changing Your Baby's Diaper



Your BABY ALIVE® Doll comes to you wearing just her sunsuit and hair ribbon. So be sure you put her Pampers® disposable diaper on before you feed her. Undress the doll and put her diaper on just as you would for a real baby, bringing the diaper up through the legs and fastening both

sides with the "tab tape" provided. (Peel backing off the "tab tape").

When she "dirties" her diaper, she needs to be cleaned before you put on her new diaper. Lay your baby doll on a towel. Remove old diaper, gently wash her with a damp cloth using mild soap and water. Dry her well and put on her diaper.

Dear Parent:

BABY ALIVE® Doll is very special. She actually chews her food and dirties her diaper just like a real baby.

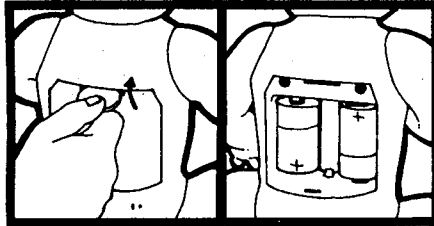
Feed BABY ALIVE® doll her special food only (also sold in BABY ALIVE® Accessory Sets). However, if other food is fed to the doll, or when your child is finished playing, clean the doll immediately.

To clean the doll, undress and undiaper her. She should be held over a sink and given a full bottle or more of water until the water comes out clear. Wipe the doll's face and body with a damp cloth.

BABY ALIVE® doll should never be immersed in water. Her hair must not be washed.

Batteries

Battery Compartment is located in doll's back. Insert a quarter and push up on it to pry open the compartment door; remove cover. Insert batteries (Uses 2 "C" size alkaline batteries, not included) as shown. Fit bottom of cover into place and snap top of cover closed.

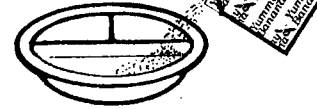


Sucking Her Thumb

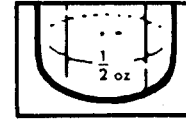
Your doll can suck her thumb by pressing it against her lower lip for a few seconds. (Mouth action lasts about 10 seconds.)



Preparing Her Food



1. Pour "food" packet contents into the dish.



= 1 Tablespoon

2. Add 1 tablespoon (1/2 oz.) of water to the "food". The bottom line on the bottle marks the correct amount of water.



3. Stir the "food" with a spoon until smooth.

Note: The doll should be fed only her special food.

Feeding Your Baby



Hold doll in your arms as shown. She begins eating when you press her spoon or bottle against her lower lip for a few seconds.

You can hold her in your arms and give her a "drink" by gently squeezing the bottle. It is suggested not to lay doll all the way down on her back when drinking to prevent diaper leakage. Make sure nipple is secure in doll's mouth to avoid spilling.

To prepare your doll for feeding, make sure she is wearing a securely fastened diaper and put on her bib. Her bib hooks in back.
